- The school counsellors engage in counselling sessions for any child undergoing anxiety or facing emotional problems of any kind.

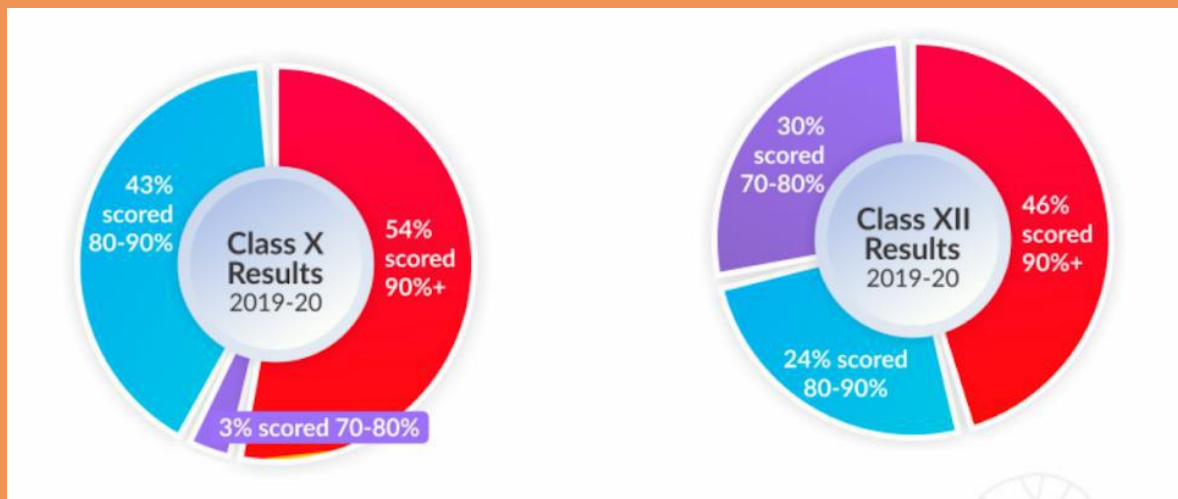


ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS:

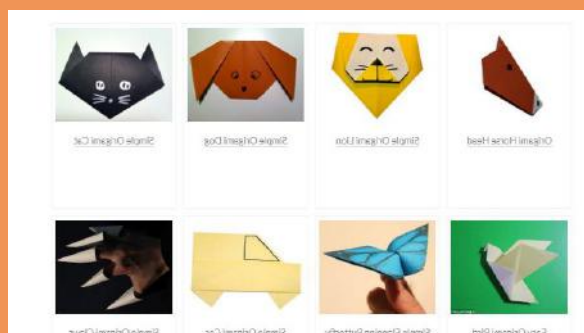

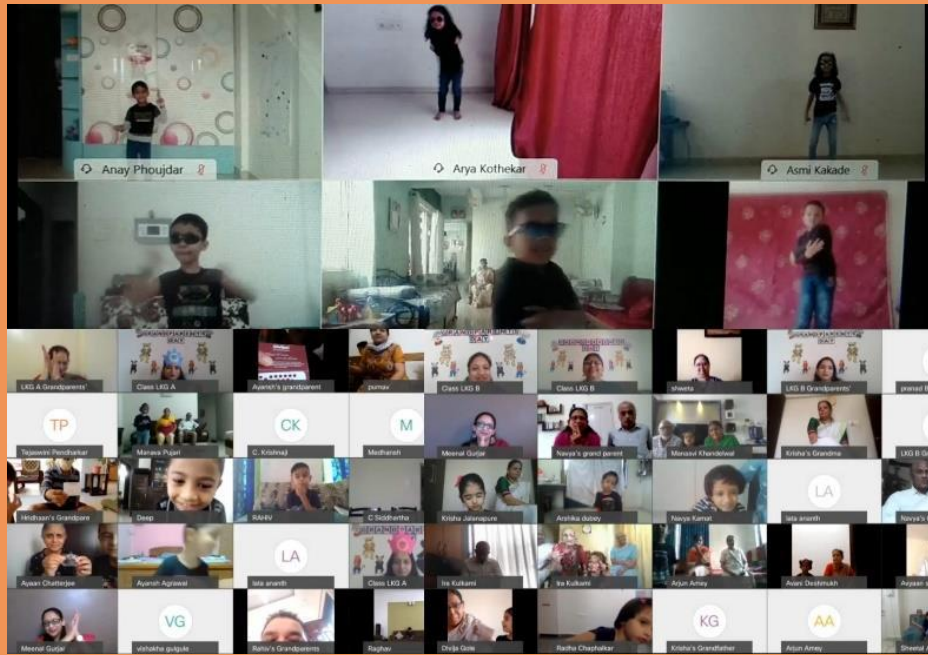
FUN DAY CELEBRATION:

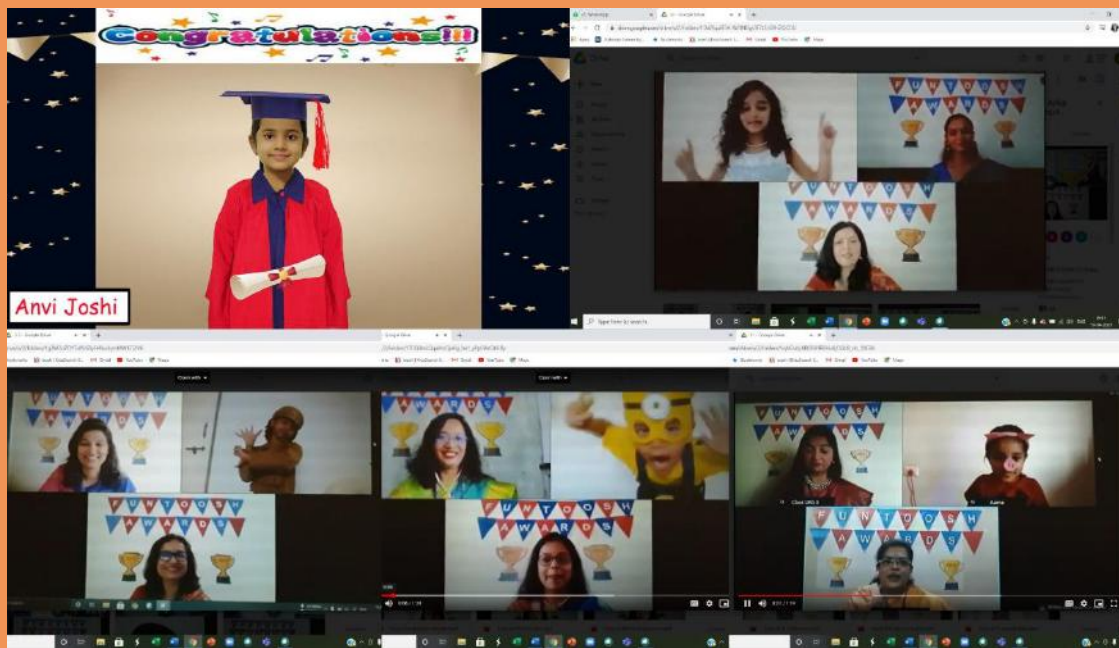
GRANDPARENTS DAY
